

LIST OF DOCUMENTS THAT VALIDATE SUFFICIENT KNOWLEDGE OF ENGLISH FOR 2023 ADMISSIONS

1. Diplomas from study programs in philology in the field of foreign languages and applied linguistics in English;
2. Document which informs of a scientific degree obtained abroad and issued by a foreign academic institution – if English was the course language¹;
3. Document which informs of a foreign degree obtained abroad, or in Poland in cooperation with a foreign academic institution – if English was the course language¹;
4. Document issued abroad equivalent to Polish Matriculation diploma (high school diploma) - if English was the course language¹;
5. International or European Baccalaureate Diploma;
6. Official certificate for certified translators;
7. The following certificates: First Certificate in English (FCE) – A, B or C, Certificate in Advanced English (CAE), Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE), Business English Certificate (BEC) Vantage – at least ‘Pass’, Business English Certificate (BEC) Higher, Certificate in English for International Business and Trade (CEIBT) – issued by University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate and University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations;
8. International English Language Testing System IELTS Academic – at least 5.5 points
9. TOEFL (min. iBT: 72 pkt., ITP: 543 pkt., CBT: 180 pkt.);

¹ Meaning that most classes and lectures were held in English
