

## Ukraine

The result of qualifications is calculated on the basis of:

- exam - Niezależnej Oceny Zewnętrznej (ZNO)/Independent External Grade (Зовнішнє незалежне оцінювання (ЗНО) – **as extended level**

or

- certificate of secondary comprehensive education (атестат про повну загальну середню освіту) – **as basic level**

Results will be calculated as follows:

<b><u>Certificate of secondary comprehensive education</u></b> – treated as <b>basic level</b> – maximum grade "12"	<b><u>Exam ZNO</u></b> – treated as <b>extended level</b> – maximum grade "100-200"
<b><u>The conversion factor 0.6.</u></b> grade 12 = 100 p. grade 11 = 92 p. grade 10 = 83 p. grade 9 = 75 p. grade 8 = 67 p. grade 7 = 58 p. grade 6 = 50 p. grade 5 = 42 p. grade 4 = 33 p.  The obtained points are multiplied by factor 0,6, for example: <b>100 x 0,6 = 60</b>	<b><u>Conversion factor</u></b>  Result of subject ZNO – 100 = points considered in the admissions process <b>e.g. 179 - 100 = 79</b>

When a foreign language or a required subject are included both in a secondary comprehensive education certificate and ZNO examination, this option is considered which, when calculated, leads to a higher grade.
