Other countries

- Foreigners, graduates of secondary schools outside the territory of Poland, may apply for admission to the first year of studies provided that their secondary education certificate has been deemed to be equivalent to the Polish secondary education certificate by virtue of the law, or pursuant to a relevant international agreement, or on the basis of an approval given by a Board of Education in Poland. It is required that a foreign certificate be translated into the Polish language by an authorised institution or a certified translator.
- Candidates must send a copy of their school leaving examination/certificate along with the translation thereof to Dział Nauczania/Unit for Teaching Administration. This will enable the University Admissions Committee to calculate individual school leaving examination grades and to determine the final number of points.
- Persons who graduated from secondary school abroad or took International Baccalaureate exams, in the case of a later date of the issue of secondary education certificates, may be **conditionally** admitted to the qualification procedures upon submission of a certificate of taking the school leaving examination, and **conditionally** admitted.
